These papers are part of the Walker Art Center's institutional records. They were created as part of the Director's Office.

Biography

Hjorvardur Harvard Arnason, known as H. Harvard Arnason, was born in 1909 in Winnipeg, Manitoba to Sveinbjorn and Maria Bjarnadottir (Arnason). He was the youngest of six children, all of whom were given both an Icelandic and an English name by their parents, who had emigrated from Iceland around 1898. Arnason spoke both Icelandic and English as a child. He attended Gordon Bell High School, Winnipeg and entered the University of Manitoba to study science. In the late 1920s after one year at university he moved with his parents to Chicago; a transition precipitated by the earlier Canadian depression. He worked in an investment banking house for 2 years and then enrolled in Northwestern University, Evanston, Illinois, obtaining his degree in English and Comparative Literature in 1931.

While Arnason continued his graduate studies at Northwestern in English Literature he took art history courses from Rensselaer W. Lee, a leading scholar and art professor at Northwestern. In 1935 he received a scholarship to study art history at Princeton University, New Jersey where the emphasis was on classical, medieval, and renaissance art. Under the tutelage of Rufus Morey, cataloger of the Museo Sacro of the Vatican, Arnason specialized in early Christian liturgical silver of Italy and Gaul. Before receiving his MFA from Princeton in 1939, Arnason lectured on art history at Northwestern and studied at the Courtauld Institute of Art, London on a scholarship.

From 1938 to 1942 Arnason worked as a Research Assistant and Lecturer for the Frick Collection, New York, where he gave several weekly lectures and Sunday radio talks about the collection. He also taught the introductory art history survey course at Hunter College, New York.

From 1942 to 1945 Arnason worked for the Office of War Information, serving for 2 years as Senior Field Representative in Iceland, and subsequently in Washington planning the long-range cultural and information policy for the U.S. in the European theater. In 1946 he was an alternate U.S. representative to the planning committee for

UNESCO, based in London and Paris, and then attended the first UNESCO session in November and December of 1946 in Paris as a Technical Advisor for the United States delegation.

In 1947 he returned to the United States to resume his career in art history as a visiting professor at the University of Chicago. He accepted the chairmanship of the newly reorganized Department of Art at the University of Minnesota in late 1947. Arnason became a member of the Walker Art Center Board of Directors in 1950 and guest-curated the exhibition, 110 American Painters at the Walker. When Daniel S. Defenbacher, Walker's then director left in the spring of 1951, Arnason, was asked by the Walker Art Center board to become temporary director. He remained for 10 years, concurrently holding his position as Director of the Art Department, University of Minnesota.

When Arnason became the Walker's director, the Art Center had a reputation for lively, innovative exhibitions, particularly in the field of design. The permanent collection included several contemporary and modern paintings but very few sculptures. He began at once to acquire sculpture for the Walker which was relatively inexpensive in the 1950s.

Many of the artworks he acquired for the Walker came from exhibitions. His exhibition program introduced major American and European artists to the area. David Smith, Stuart Davis, Saul Baizerman, Jacques Lipchitz, Alexander Calder, Barbara Hepworth, and Gerhard Marcks were among those given one-person shows (see Exhibition Files) and whose works were added to the collection.

During his time at the Walker Arnason also worked to broaden the scope of the programming to include lectures, films, dance, and music by creating an affiliated volunteer organization called the Center Arts Council in 1953 (see Performing Arts Files).

While in Minneapolis, Arnason and his wife, Elizabeth (Hickox Yard) Arnason, lived with their two children, Eleanor and Jon in Idea House II, an exhibition house of contemporary design, built by the Walker on a hill behind the museum in 1947 (see Idea Houses Oral History and Director's papers: Daniel S. Defenbacher).

In 1955 Arnason was awarded a Fulbright Fellowship and spent a year in Paris researching the history of renaissance and modern sculpture. The Walker Art Center was left in the charge of Sidney Simon, Assistant Director. Again in 1958, Arnason was away from the Walker for a year, teaching at the University of Hawaii and then traveling and lecturing for the State Department throughout Japan, Korea, the Philippines, Hong Kong, Pakistan, Afghanistan, Iran, and Israel. Martin Friedman, who had joined the Walker staff as Senior Curator in 1958, served as Acting Director in Arnason's absence.

In December 1960 Arnason accepted the position of Vice President at the Solomon R. Guggenheim Foundation, New York. After he left the Walker, Martin Friedman became the next director in 1961. Arnason remained at the Guggenheim Foundation until he retired in 1969.

During his lifetime, Arnason wrote many books, monographs, and articles on medieval, 18th-century and modern art. A History of Modern Art one of his most famous books became a standard college textbook. For illustration in that book, Arnason selected many works from the Walker Art Center that he had purchased for the permanent collection, including Nike by Saul Baizerman, Colonial Cubism by Stuart Davis and The Royal Bird by David Smith.

Throughout his life he maintained his connection to the Walker as a colleague and a trustee of the T.B. Walker Foundation. H. Harvard Arnason died on May 28, 1986, in New York.

Scope and Content

The H. Harvard Arnason Papers, 1951-1960, is the second series in the record group Director's Office. Within the Arnason Papers, are subseries: Alphabetical Files, Artists Correspondence and Chronological Files. The Alphabetical Files constitute the bulk of the series, and are the files kept by the Director's Office containing correspondence, office memos, lists, brochures, telegrams, packing and shipping orders, photographs and clippings. The Director's Office includes the curatorial staff as well, and within these papers will be found correspondence of William M. Friedman, Assistant Director from 1943-1952; Huldah Curl, Curatorial Assistant from 1949-1961; Norman Nagle, Curator of Architecture from 1952-1953; Sidney Simon, Senior Curator from 1953-1958; James Elliott, Curatorial Assistant from 1953-1956; Meg Torbert, Design Curator, 1951-1963; and Martin Friedman who joined the staff in 1958 as Senior Curator.

The folders within the Alphabetical Files are arranged alphabetically by their headings and then chronologically by year. Overall, they reflect the day-to-day operations of the museum, as well as the organizations and people with whom Arnason was professionally connected. Many folder headings recur frequently. *Packing and Shipping Orders* are the forms filled out whenever artworks were shipped out or received by the Walker. *Telegrams*, a prominent folder heading throughout the 1940's and early 1950's, disappears by the end of the 1950's. *A-Z Correspondence Files* are the general correspondence of Arnason. *Travel* folders contain notes and schedules about Arnason's many trips. *Exhibitions Possible* and *Impossible contain* correspondence and notes about exhibitions which never materialized. *Dealers* contains correspondence and

brochures from dealers and commercial galleries around the country about various exhibitions and artists. *Walker Art Center: Board of Directors* traces the increasing involvement of the Walker Board of Directors in the museum's activities, including fundraising, programming and acquisitions.

Several folder headings indicate ways in which the institution evolved under Arnason's directorship. For example, *Staff Worksheets* contain minutes of staff meetings and detailed lists of work assignments and reflects the administrative reforms Arnason undertook at the Art Center as he sought to simultaneously manage two institutions: the Walker Art Center and the Department of Art at the University of Minnesota. Throughout the 1950's, certain museum activities, including *Education*, and *Membership*, began to take on more prominence and eventually developed into departments within the Art Center. Diane Williams was hired as the first Educational Curator in 1955, and immediately began summer art classes and an on-going educational program for the Walker [Box 19, Folders 14--20]. *Tours and Lectures* become a function of this department, and are subsequently filed under *Education*. Inquiries about the *Walker Art Center School* continue an entire decade after closing in 1949. Recognition of the importance of museum membership prompts initiatives to sustain and increase that important component of the Art Center, like the *Member's Open House* on March 28, 1954 [Box 16, Folder 08].

Films, music and lectures, had been offered occasionally at the Art Center, but became permanent features of Arnason's expanded vision of the Walker's program. There were regular film series, presentations of music performances and many lectures including the 1960 series *The Critic, the Artist and the Public* with lectures by Erik

Barnouw, Alfred Frankenstein, Alfred Kazin, Authur Knight, Hilton Kramer and Gilbert Seldes [Box 34, Folders 09-13].

Many of the lectures, films and music performances presented at the Walker in the 1950's were sponsored by the *Center Arts Council* (CAC)[Box 12, Folder 11]. The CAC was formed in 1953 by members of the Walker Art Center dedicated to the presentation of contemporary performing arts--music, opera, drama, film. This volunteer organization was a formative influence at the Walker, and in the community at large throughout the 1950's and sparked the initial proposals for the *Guthrie Theatre* by Oliver Rea and Peter Zeisler [Box 34, Folders 29-32] in 1960. Besides presenting events, the CAC oversaw the operation of the *Sales and Rental Gallery* in conjunction with curator Huldah Curl. In 1957 and 1958 the Sales and Rental program was given an operating grant by the Rockefeller Foundation [Box 30, Folder 15] (see also: Administration).

Arnason established the fine arts as the primary focus of the exhibition program at the Walker Art Center in the 1950's, while the applied arts and architecture, which were the dominant programs in the previous decade, assumed a supporting role. As a result, the Everyday Art Gallery became the Design Gallery, and the *Everyday Art Quarterly* became the *Design Quarterly*. The first several issues of *Design Quarterly* were guest edited by Belle Krasne [Box 15, Folder 08: *Belle Krasne: Design Quarterly*] until Meg Torbert, (who left the Walker Art Center staff in 1952) returned as design curator and *Design Quarterly* editor in 1955.

From the beginning of his directorship Arnason was keenly interested in building the Walker's permanent collection, with a particular emphasis on sculpture [Box 14, Folder 12: *Walker Art Center: Purchase Policy*]. An *Acquisition* (sometimes called

Purchase) Committee was established by the Board of Directors in 1951 and a systematic effort to augment the Walker's collection with contemporary sculpture and painting was undertaken. To that end, the dealers with whom Arnason corresponds are, for the most part, different from those Defenbacher dealt with in the 1940's, and represent a new generation of artists. The dealers represented in these files can be found in Galleries / Dealers and include: Sam Kootz, Curt Valentin, Martha Jackson, Catherine Viviano, Edith Halpert, and Bertha Shaefer. When Martin Friedman arrives at the Walker in 1958, he undertakes an extensive evaluation of past acquisitions [Box 27; Folder 06 Acquisitions: Research and Reports, 1958-1960].

The overlap of Arnason's parallel position as head of the Art Department at the University is evident in the many folders labeled *University*, and in his extensive correspondence with local artists who were also on the faculty of the University, including John Rood, Harold Tovish, Marianne Pineda and Kyle Morris. He was also mindful of filling staff positions at both institutions as is apparent in folders labeled *Applicants*. Arnason conducted laborious searches for Walker staff positions and would simultaneously search for candidates qualified to teach at the University or work at the University Gallery. One of the benefits of Arnason's position at both institutions was his interest in engaging students in the arts. Young people were encouraged to attend openings and lectures at the Walker and could attend events for half-price.

Arnason had a wide association with other museum directors around the country, who he corresponded with regularly, among them were Grace L. McCann Morley [Box 17 Folder 8 *San Francisco Museum of Art*, 1954]; Daniel Catton Rich, Art Institute of Chicago; James Plaut [Box 13 Folder 11 *Institute of Contemporary Art, Boston*, 1953];

Perry Rathbone, St. Louis Museum of Art and Museum of Fine Arts, Boston; and James Johnson Sweeney, Guggenheim Museum. In 1952 Arnason and Adelyn Breeskin of the Baltimore Museum of Art, established the Museum Exhibition Exchange [Box 09, Folder 13 *Museum Cooperative: Museum Exhibition Association*, 1952-1955]. This was a cooperative exhibition exchange program between twelve member institutions, all of them committed to contemporary art.

Arnason was involved in many professional arts organizations as well. He was a member of the Executive Committee of the *American Federation of Arts* (AFA), and was also very active as a member of the Editorial Committee of the *Magazine of Arts*. He was a member of the *American Museum Association* and the *Association of American Museum Directors*. He was also a member of the Artist Equity Association, the Midwest College Art Association and served on the Arts Committee for the *Minnesota Statehood Centennial* [Box 30 Folder 03, 1958]. He served on many juries, most notably to select young American artists for the exhibit sponsored by the AFA for the 1958 *Brussels Universal and International Exhibition* [Box 23, Folder 18].

A notable feature of Arnason's tenure as Director of the Walker is his prolonged absenteeism from the institution which is reflected in these files. Between 1953 and 1958 Sidney Simon is periodically acting director, and then Martin Friedman, who replaces Simon in 1958, is acting director from 1959 to 1960. Simon and Friedman take on the many managerial tasks in running the Art Center while keeping Arnason informed from his various locations.

The Subseries Artists Correspondence contain the original letters sent by artists to the Director's Office. They have been preseved in mylar sleeves, and filed alphabetically by name. Copies of these letters can be found within the Alphabetical Files. These letters will be indexed by artist name.

The Subseries Chronological Files are carbon copies of Arnason's correspondence arranged chronologically. The Chron Files have not been processed as they are duplicates of the Alphabetical Files.
